

Declaration on environmental impact

TØIs activities do not pollute the outdoor environment. TØI became certified as an Eco-lighthouse during the spring of 2015, which ensures best practice in eco-friendly management of the work environment, waste management, energy consumption, procurement, and transport. TØI follows the Eco-lighthouse norms for the recycling of paper, electrical items, plastic packaging, etc. Furthermore, the office areas are equipped with motion detection light switches and window blinds etc.

TØI is established in the eco-friendly building CIENS - Oslo Centre for Interdisciplinary Environmental and Social Research. The building was completed in 2006, and features eco-friendly solutions within areas such as:

- Energy consumption: Solar panels produce hot water, and a geothermal heat pump covers most cooling and heating requirements
- Materials: Emphasis is placed on selecting environmentally friendly materials, without substances harmful to health or the environment
- Waste management: A system has been established to ensure eco-friendly waste management
- Outdoors: Limited car use is ensured through functional bicycle parking, and proximity to public transport.
